Topics will include an overview of restorative justice; update on legislative action that will effect prisoners and/or families of prisoners and/or restorative justice ministry; TDCJ Chaplaincy report; and curriculum available for studies with inmates.

The local steering committee has designed a conference that will inform and encourage new and/or potential volunteers and refresh seasoned volunteers whose ministry is with prisoners, the formerly incarcerated and/or their families.
